SUBJECT: 183<sup>rd</sup> FW Environmental Management Policy

1. The 183<sup>rd</sup> Fighter Wing in Springfield, Illinois is committed to conducting its mission (Air and Space Operations Center and a Centralized Intermediate Repair Facility for the General Electric F110 Jet Engine) in an environmentally responsible manner that will protect human health, natural resources, and the environment. In doing so, we will strive for compliance with all environmental laws, and other requirements applicable to the conduct of our mission and strive for continual improvement in our environmental performance. This commitment goes beyond compliance with the law and encompasses the integration of sound environmental practices into our daily decisions and activities. We have in the past, and will continue in the future, to pursue a course of responsible environmental stewardship.
2. The 183<sup>rd</sup> FW commits to reduce the environmental impacts and consumption of natural resources from our operations and strive for compliance with all legal and applicable requirements. We further commit to continually improve on our success in environmental stewardship. The Environmental Management System of the 183<sup>rd</sup> Fighter Wing integrates our efforts to achieve the following goals:
  - Maintain an effective environmental management system, promote the use of safe technologies and operating practices, and remain ready to respond to emergencies in order to improve our environmental performance and minimize adverse impacts to installation workers, their families, and the environment.
  - Set environmental goals, measure progress, take corrective action when necessary. Maintain an open dialogue with our workers, the community, suppliers, regulators and the public.
  - Investigate and evaluate new and innovative technologies and practices as appropriate, establish and implement an effective pollution prevention program, minimize the generation of wastes, recycle materials otherwise destined to become waste when possible, and dispose of any remaining wastes in an environmentally responsible manner.
  - Ensure the responsible use of energy throughout the installation, including the adoption of innovative practices and procedures that will conserve energy and improve energy efficiency.
  - Provide regular operation-specific environmental performance reviews and assessments, and develop plans to address actual or potential noncompliance situations.
3. Compliance with this Environmental Policy is the responsibility of every member of the 183<sup>rd</sup> Fighter Wing community and everyone working on behalf of the 183<sup>rd</sup> Fighter Wing, in accordance with his or her role and responsibilities in the organization.
