Colonel Ronald E. Paul is Director of Logistics, First Air Force (AFNORTH) and Continental U.S. North American Defense Command Region (CONR), Tyndall AFB, FL. The directorate provides maintenance engineering, supply, transportation, and logistics direction for AFNORTH and CONR. The directorate also conducts Aerospace Control Alert operational assessments in support of Operation Noble Eagle and oversees wartime and contingency planning and sustainment of Air Forces fielded in support of U.S. Northern Command and NORAD. Additionally, the directorate is responsible for providing logistics support in support of civilian authorities during times of crisis, natural, and man-made disasters.



Colonel Paul was born in Cudahy, Wisconsin. He entered active duty after graduation from the United States Air Force Academy in 1988. He has served in a variety of positions including Squadron Maintenance Officer in the 19th Fighter Squadron, Elmendorf AFB, AK; USAF Logistics Career Broadening Officer at Ogden Air Logistics Center; Deputy Chief, Technical Repair Division at Ogden Air Logistics Center; Commander of the 183rd Maintenance Squadron, 183rd Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, and 183rd Mission Support Group at Springfield, IL. Col Paul has deployed in support of contingency operations to Europe and Southwest Asia multiple times. He also served as the senior USAF military officer for the initial F-16 Aircraft Maintenance Training Team in Poland.

Col Paul has been a maintainer on F-111A, EF-111A, F-15C/D, and F-16C/D aircraft.
